

Delores Pancheta McCall-Ferguson

Delores Pancheta McCall-Ferguson was born on March 17, 1942 in Spanish Town, St. Catherine, Jamaica to Gladys Maud Stevens and Stanford McCall. She was the last of six children. She attended St. Catherine Primary and later Crescent All Age School. After she finished school, she learned sewing under the guidance of a local seamstress in Spanish Town. She later started working at the Peter Pan Brassiere Factory in Spanish Town until it closed at which time she transferred to the Elite Brassiere Factory in Kingston, Jamaica. She worked there until she immigrated to the United States in 1986.

Delores got married in 1987 to Barrington Ferguson and has lived in Washington, D.C. for 33 years. She worked at Georgetown Hospital in the Environmental Services Department until she retired due to disability in 2001. She was a hardworking individual who always ensured her family was provided for.

She was a kind, reliable, trustworthy, and loyal person. She loved her family dearly and would go above and beyond for her siblings, kids, grandkids, nieces, nephews, and close friends. She was lighthearted and very funny, always the life of the party, making those around her laugh.

Delores suffered a stroke in 2013 and her health has since declined. In July 2019, she became ill and was hospitalized with pneumonia and while in the hospital she suffered a massive heart attack which left her dependent on a ventilator. She peacefully went home to be with the Lord on Saturday, December 14, 2019.

She is survived by her husband Barrington; her 3 sons (Hector, Horace, and Christopher); 8 grandchildren (Sean, Horace, Tyrell, Tyron, Jamaal, Diamond, Christopher Jr., Chrishan); 7 great grandchildren (Nasir, Nevaeh, Mariah, Caleb, Carter, Khlo, and Richie); 2 sisters [Delserina (Mackie) and Enez (Netibel)], many nieces and nephews and her dear friend Joyce of many years.


