Deacon Henry Shakespeare White attended Emmanuel Baptist Church where he sang in the Men's Chorus and served as a Deacon, for several decades. Church gave him a sense of peace and an opportunity to give back to the Lord he loved.

On December 2, 2020 he departed this life peacefully when the Lord called him home. Henry was able to leave this life with his wife Roselle White, who he referred to as Zet, and his loving daughter Harriett, who he loving called Hank and his dog, Blue were all

there by his side. Henry has joined his parents, Willie & Pearlie; Marianne (daughter), sisters, Dorothy, Mary, Janie, Florence, Pearlie, Orsie and brother, Willie Jr in Heaven.
