Robert Henry Sanders was born to the late Josephine Smith and Walter Jones, Sr. on October 28, 1943, in Weems, VA. Robert's spiritual journey began with him joining Sharon Baptist Church, accepting Christ at an early age, while attending Lancaster Public Schools. He graduated from Brookvale High School in 1963.

Robert felt the Lord expanding his journey and he moved to Baltimore, MD in the late 60s. He was trained in electronics, which led him to work as a technician at General Electric for over 15 years. After leaving GE, Robert's interest in computing and photography became paramount and he obtained a position of A/V Specialist at Coppin State University which he held for nearly 20 years.

As he served the Lord over the years, Robert found his home at First Christian Community Baptist Church. He became a devout and faithful Sunday School and Vacation Bible School instructor at First Christian. Church life, along with his beloved family, remained at the center of Robert's life. He was very close to his Pastor, Rev. Tucker.

He received a Bachelor's degree in 2009, continuing to seek more the Divine Word, and received a Master's degree in 2012, finishing with a Doctorate from Northwestern Bible College (NBC) in 2013.

Robert traveled extensively, visiting the Carriibbean, Africa, London, Rome, and three times to the Holy Land. He loved to share stories of his travel with all, especially with his cherished Aunt Hazel, to whom he was sure to give a beautiful gift with his every travel. Whether abroad or local, cuisine was of interest and earned Robert the family title of "Connoisseur".

Through his gift of laughter, Robert's presence was always sure to bring good times and fun. He loved to record musical CDs and make gifts of them. Videography was also a passion.

The Lord rewarded Robert for his service hundredfold, and answered the prayers of his heart through his soulmate Brenda. Brenda and Robert were inseparable and in love, and went everywhere together. In 2014, Robert and Brenda were joined in holy matrimony. Dr. Bob, as he was affectionately known at Church, was a faithful servant, always kept good spirits and never complained. He wanted it to be known, that no matter what, he

would still trust God for the rest of his days. On November 30, 2019, Robert received his medal from God, for “a journey, well done”.
