“ I am Lorna Semple, Wolsey Semple’s biological niece, I live in Toronto .Canada. I am from Guyana (formerly British Guyana)
Uncles Wolsey was loved, respected, and adored by everyone. He was my Idol.
As far back as I can remember we lived in a big house with many rooms , at Lichfield one of the biggest house in the village.
We had a big vat (cistern) that contained gallons rain water, the only house in the village a big vat.
Where most people went to the village well, we had our vat.

Wolsey’s father, my grandfather was a money lender, a pawn broker, a land owner and a cattle rancher. His nick name was BANK .He has an iron safe at home where he kept all his documents, jewelry, money ETC. The big house had lots of rooms and glass windows a walk way leading to a big adjoining kitchen.
Uncle grew up in a family that was self sufficient and well off.
I can remember back when I was about 3 or 4years old, my uncle taught me how to use my brains, to memorize, my ABC count 1,2,3 and to recite. In so doing he paid me one penny, two penny, the English currency. It was a lot of money for a 3 year old in 1949 or 1950 thereabout.
To excel, to achieve, we Samples were taught at a young age. And I saw Uncle Wolsey applying the same technique to others in the family whose names I would not mention.
Today, I thank my Uncle Wolsey for teaching me self respect, to excel, to achieve, to be self sufficient how to be kind to others.


