



## Alberta Simon

February 28, 1928 - May 25, 2020

Alberta Simon was born February 28th, 1928, in Camden, South Carolina. The eldest daughter and last living child of Hazel Robinson and Elizabeth (Brown) Robinson, her younger years were spent helping with the family farm along with her brothers, Thomas James (TJ) and Willy Robinson, and sisters Mary Mingo, Cora Lee Williams, Bessie Blyther, Lula Mae Washington, Abelle Myers, and Gladys Pearson. She was considered quite disciplined in her approach to life and gained respect due to her unwavering tenacity. According to her baby sister Gladys, "Alberta was tough."

She married Murray Simon Sr. (deceased) December 25 1950. They moved to Washington DC in the 50's to start a family. She worked as a housekeeper in the DC area for a few years, then left working outside of the home to focus solely on caring for her family.

Her presence stretched greatly in the Northeast DC neighborhood for seven decades where she adhered to the extended family model, as well as provided home cooked soul food and guidance to relatives (nieces, nephews, cousins), close families in the neighborhood and her church community.

She found her longtime church family at Purity Baptist Church in the 1950's, where she has been honored for her dedicated service.

Alberta passed peacefully in her sleep the morning of May 25th, 2020. She is survived by her five children, Bobby, Betty, Teann, Michelle, and Murray Simon, Jr; five grandchildren, Keena Simon, LaCretia "Cree" Simon, Talesia Simon-Bush (husband Brian Bush), Lorenzo Simon, and Brittany Simon-Jones (husband Joesph Jones); great grandchildren, Zoshawn Simon (13), Gregory Simon (12), Miracle Mason (10), Ryleigh Jones (8), Raevyn Jones (4), Rian Bush (8 months) and Zara Simon (1 month). 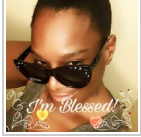
