December 8, 1943 - January 5, 2020

On Sunday, January 5, 2020, In care of Capitol Caring Hospice at Providence Hospital, Washington, DC God in his mercy quietly beckoned his daughter Anita to receive his reward. Anita Brent Spriggs, daughter of the late Phillip and Mildred Spriggs was born on December 8, 1943 at 909 M St. N.W. Washington, DC. Her sisters Dorothy and Shirley, brothers David (Dickey) and Phillip Jr. (Tex), preceded her in death.

At age 11, she and the family moved to the present location on (Fairmont St NW) where Anita received her public education at Monroe Elementary, Banneker Jr. High and Cardozo Sr. High School. After High School, she started working at the old Yale laundry as a laundry Apprentice, alongside her sister Shirley (she only lasted one week), that is when she borrowed five hundred dollars from her father and purchased her first cab, she was a taxi driver for Washington, DC from the (age of 21 until age 73). In 1989 she entered the Federal Government, working at the Walter Reed Hospital (Ga. Ave.) in environmental services, she received various awards from Sr. Military Officers for (Work Will Done), she retired from Walter Reed Hospital, in May of 2011. During her early childhood, Anita attended Sunday School and was baptized at Vermont Avenue Baptist Church, Washington, DC. Anita was easy to get along with and everybody adored her, she was always willing to lend a helping hand and had the ability to make you feel safe. She enjoyed sports and playing cards with family and friends. While driving her cab and working at Walter Reed, she became friends with many people she met. She loved her

family and was instrumental in helping her sister Shirley raise her girls (Sheryl, Annette, Donna, Darlene Jackie and Lisa).

She leaves to cherish in her memory, one brother George Spriggs, Cousins Robert Randall (Bobby), Yvette Long and Clarence English, devoted Friends Bernice, Cynthia, Noreata, Joyce and a host of Nieces Nephews and Friends.
