Anna Mae Caldwell passed away peacefully on December 2, 2024, at the Medstar Washington Hospital Center after a brief illness. She was 77 years old. She was the second child of two children born to the late Jessie and Eula Mae (Freeman) Dozier in Washington DC on April 11, 1947.

Anna was a proud lifelong resident of Washington, DC. She attended DC Public Schools and graduated from Theodore Roosevelt High School in 1966. She began her professional career at Geico before dedicating over 20 years of service at the United States Postal Service (USPS), retiring in 2017. Anna was married to Jonathan K. and compassion. She left an enduring impression on everyone she encountered. Her radiant smile and warm spirit brought joy to all who knew her.
