February 10, 1941 - September 4, 2018

Annie Quinette Jackson affectionately known as “Nettie”, was born at Garfield Memorial Hospital, Washington, DC on February 10, 1941 to the late Radcliffe and Annie Barksdale. She was the seventh of nine children. She was preceded in death by four brothers Norman, Bennaugh, Earl and Clifford; and three sisters Gracella, Barbara and Carolyn.

On Tuesday, September 4, 2018, at MedStar Washington Hospital Center, Washington, DC, Nettie departed this life after a period of illness.

She received her early education in the Washington, DC public school system.

Nettie and Clarence James Jackson, affectionately known as “Jack” were introduced by Sandra Lee, a long-time friend. On August 15, 1961, she married Jack.
