



## Rev Dr. Arthur Stroud Sr.

June 22, 1943 - July 25, 2020

“TO EVERY THING THERE IS A SEASON, AND A TIME TO EVERY PURPOSE UNDER THE HEAVEN:”

Dr. Stroud was known for his interest in outreach to the community. His outreach ministries included: encouragement in implementing the Saturday Church School in the 37th Place Neighborhood (encouraging children to become involved in church activities), assisting Minister Ronald Greenfield and others with implementing the Burrito and Ice Cream Evangelism Ministry, held on the Church parking lot, serving all ages of community participants. Dr. Stroud bridged the connection between St. Judah Spiritual Church and Upper Room, encouraging joint worship during Christmas and Thanksgiving each year. He encouraged and helped to implement worship services at the Allen House Senior Citizen Home each first Sunday. He instituted evangelism at the service station across the street from Upper Room. Dr. Stroud encouraged Upper Room Baptist Church to visit other churches for revival service. He instituted the Food Pantry, a ministry designed to help feed those in the community who need food. He also encouraged church and local community connection with the Civic Association, having Evangelist Johnson become liaison for this ministry. Dr. Stroud recommended and ordained Brother Larry Newsome as Deacon on July 12, 2009.

Dr. Stroud always took time to remind each parishioner of the seriousness and holiness involved in carrying out the Communion Ordinance. Each time he

administered Communion Service, he built in a quiet wait moment for each parishioner to focus on the purpose before partaking of the sacraments.

Dr. Stroud conducted and participated in workshops held for the growth of the Church. Dr. Stroud found much joy in attending the Adult Sunday School Class taught by Deacon Knight.

Dr. Stroud was the epitome of warmth and friendship. He refused to allow anyone to leave his presence without a smile or a good laugh. His smile and laughter would fill an entire room. Dr. Stroud earned respect through genuine love for people.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Samuel and Ruby Pate Stroud; brother, Jimmy Stroud, Sr. (Barbara), aunts, Fannie Mae Pate Allen, Elnora Pate Lockhart, Julia Pate Green, and Irine Pate; uncles, Curtis Pate, Rufus Pate, James Pate, Charlie Lockhart, Charlie Allen, Albert Kendall and James Green, niece, Ruby Green.
