Audrey Patricia Herndon-Walls was born on April 5, 1952, in Washington, DC. She left us unexpectedly on May 29, 2026.

Audrey was the oldest of three children born to Carl Patrick Herndon and Earline Jane Williams. However, the greatest influence on Audrey's life came from her grandmother, the late Lucia Herndon, and her aunt, the late Audrey Ligans, whom she lived with during her adolescent and early adult years. They instilled in Audrey the importance of Christian stewardship, shaped by the Catholic Church, and a strong work ethic, which she carried throughout her life.

She was very proud to have been born and raised in Washington, DC. Audrey attended DC public schools, beginning at Ruth K Webb Elementary. Audrey continued her education by taking college courses at the University of the District of Columbia and Howard University.

In 1998, Audrey began working at the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) as an office clerk in the Office of Air and Radiation. Throughout her career, she received numerous awards for her dedication and hard work. Her kind nature made her well-liked among her co-workers. Audrey remained with the EPA until her retirement in June 2025.

In 2007, Audrey married Vodrick Darnell “Dee” Walls, and they spent 19 years together until her passing. Over the years, they attended concerts, movie premieres, and cookouts, always enjoying music and dancing. Their favorite pastime was cheering for their teams: the Washington Redskins (Commanders), the Nationals, and the Wizards.
