Charles Ricardo Wells — professionally known as C. R. Wells, and affectionately called “Rickey” by family and friends — passed away on May 8, 2026, at the age of 73.

Born on April 19, 1953, in Washington, D.C., Rickey was raised in the District by his late parents, Gladys and James Wells, and attended Calvin Coolidge High School. Rickey served as a Junior Deacon at Second New Saint Paul Baptist Church. He built a working life rooted in service, spending years as a transporter at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport.

Off the clock, he lived by a simple manifesto: “To Seek & Find ART.” A gifted mixed media artist and painter, Rickey was known for his striking abstracts and lifelike portraits — work that revealed the quiet depth of the man behind the brush.

Reserved, talented, and content to live a simple life, Rickey loved his family deeply and was a lifelong cinephile who could recite every word of his favorite film, *Pulp Fiction*.

He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Brenda Wells. He leaves behind his devoted sisters, Brenda Fortune, Diane Williams (Charles), and Sylvia Davis (Danny), to cherish his memory, along with a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, and friends.
