He enjoyed and loved working. He only stopped when he got very sick and couldn't continue his work. He loved his family very much and always enjoyed

He had a ministry of help. He would have liked to help the whole world if it were possible. He was the chief sponsor and the Treasurer of “Hope for The Needy and Evangelical Foundation Inc.”, an organization inaugurated in 2021 here in United States that helps the poor and the less privileged in society.
