Clarence Darnell Allen was born in Marietta, Georgia, December 22, 1966. He spent his formative years in West Point, Mississippi. There, he confessed Christ and was baptized at Northside Christian Church at a very early age. His music ministry began with his older brother, Steven at Blackjack Baptist Church, Starkville, Mississippi, and continued throughout grammar and high school. Clarence graduated from West Point High School and enlisted in the United States Army in 1984.

After Darnell completed his military duty, he became an ordained Minister of the Gospel. Subsequently, he received a Bachelor of Theology, Houston Baptist University, a Master of Divinity, Princeton Theological Seminary, and a Doctor of Management/Organizational Leadership, University of Phoenix. Clarence served as Pastor of the Peoples United Methodist Church, Colorado Springs, Colorado. Reverend Allen made a lasting impact as a preacher, organist, and dedicated teacher for over four decades. Throughout his career, he touched countless lives with his passion for ministry and commitment to nurturing young minds. His patience and understanding created an environment where students felt empowered to reach their full potential. He was also a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Reverend Clarence and Pinkie Louise Allen, and eldest brother, Michael Ray Allen. He leaves behind an enduring legacy of love, kindness, and unwavering strength to his beloved son, Joshua Darnell Allen, brothers, Steven Mark Allen, and Dexter Wade Allen, two nieces, Katina, and Maresha, three nephews, Johnathan, Samuel, and Michael, a host of cousins, and other relatives and friends.
