“ We were extremely sad to hear about Cliff's passing. He was the finest of human beings--thoughtful and compassionate--and he had a subtle and hugely wry sense of humor. Here is one memorable story he told: Cliff was sitting at the desk in his office at Colby (was it on a Saturday?) when the parents of a student, visiting campus for Parent's Weekend and wanting to meet their child's favorite professor, showed up at the door looking for Professor Reid. Cliff calmly informed them that Professor Reid would be back in fifteen minutes. The couple returned fifteen minutes later only to find him still sitting at his desk. What a divinely clever way to call out the racist assumptions of the parents, who (according to Cliff) took him for the janitor the first time around. Ultimately the story is tragic rather than funny, but Cliff drew the humor out of the scenario.

Because I had the pleasure of working in the same department as Cliff's wife Sheila for many years, I was lucky enough to visit their home on many occasions. Cliff and Sheila were an ideal couple. They entertained with great bounty and generosity, always making guests feel deeply welcome (and probably overstaying our welcome!) Cliff's love for, and devotion to, Sheila in the last years has been amply evident, as was their pride in, and love for, Matt and his young family.
