



Daniel David Bowles

April 1, 1931 - June 4, 2020

Daniel David Bowles, who was affectionately known as Sonny, passed away at the age of 89 on June 4, 2020. The youngest of 17 children, Sonny was born on April 1, 1931 to James Robert Bowles and Laura Lee Bigsby in Ashburn, Virginia. In High School, his skills in basketball were impressive and he shined on the court. At the age of 20, he accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior, and was baptized at Emmanuel Baptist Church in Wash., D.C. The next year he married his sweetheart, Evelyn Grace Montague. Sonny and Evelyn made their home in Washington, D.C. In their marriage, they produced two beautiful children. Later in life, Sonny and Evelyn, who is known as Babe by those who love her, traveled across the nation in their Ford Conversion van.

In 1952, Sonny joined the U.S. Army where he rose to the rank of Corporal. He was honorably discharged in 1954 after returning from the Korean War. Mr. Bowles continued on in the United States Reserves until 1961. He worked the Montague Fuel Oil Co., the Best Foods SuperMarket, and then at the Federal Bureau of Engraving as a Special Police Officer until he retired. Sonny was a self-taught musician who played the guitar, loved the Wonky-Tonk sound and the smooth rhythm of jazz. Sonny had a knack of finding ways to make money. He repaired TV's and radios, and was Uber before there was such a thing called Uber or Lyfft!
