Deacon Richard Leon Walker, Jr was born on March 6, 1950, in Washington, DC and he was proceeding in death by his mother Lillian Walker and his father Richard L. Walker, Sr., and his stepmother Irene E. Walker, two sisters Denise Taylor and Carolyn Love (Leroy), one niece Barbara Taylor. He went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, October 12, 2023, at 8:00 pm at the Inova Alexandria Hospital in Alexandria, VA.

Deacon Walker attended public schools in the Washington, DC. Metropolitan area, he was in the ROTC in High School, and after graduating from Ballou Senior High School, he later went on to join the DC Army National Guard's upon completing his time as a Captain. He then went on to join the U.S. Army Reserves and retired as a Drill Sergeant with honors from both military branch of service. Deacon Richard worked in different jobs fields after retiring from the military, but the one he enjoyed the working the most was for Catholic Charities, he loved going above and beyond to helping others that were less fortunate. He would even sometimes pay peoples bills out of his own pockets.

Deacon Walker accepted Christ at a young age at St. Thomas More Catholic Church and later went on to join St. Luke's Catholic Church. Deacon Richard

served as a mentor to the deacons and new deacons coming on board as well. He was very loved at his church and other organizations that he was involved in before passing.

Deacon Walker is survived by five sisters: His devoted sister Terra Bryant (Frank), who was his ride or die and main care giver upon his passing, Joslin Miller (Clyde) of Ft. Washington, MD, Rhonda Walker, Mona Walker of New Brunswick, NJ, and Shonda Perry of Atlanta, GA and four brothers Michael Walker (Della), who also help with caring for him, Anthony Walker (April), Garnell Stewart (Pidor Chea) of Falls Church, VA, and Michael Stewart of South Carolina.
