In her career, she was compassionate, smart, charismatic and business savvy. Dee was fearless in trying new things and courageous enough to do things she had never seen done before. Dee had a fix to every problem. She also enjoyed writing music, shopping and being fashionable, gardening and lawncare, her dog Nyla, traveling and generally being a “Pioneer Woman” (as she called herself) paving the way.

Dee loved and invested into the life of her one daughter, Dartania, and in the life of her 4 young grandchildren, Daniel (11), Joelle (9), Judah (6) and Emmanuel (4). Her grandchildren were her light during hard times, and a source of strength and great happiness. They recount fond memories of going on walks and eating at McDonald’s with “Granny”, a name she picked herself and treasured. Friends and family will remember her as beautiful, strong, bold, fearless, witty, charming and passionate. She truly brought beauty, style and laughter into the lives of everyone she touched. Dee was truly unforgettable, one of a kind, and she will be missed dearly.
