



Derrick A. Jeter

May 22, 1970 - September 18, 2025

It is with deep sorrow that we announce the passing of Derrick Arthur Jeter of Oxon Hill Maryland. Derrick transitioned peacefully on Thursday, September 18, 2025 at the age of 55. Born in Rheinland-Pfalz, Germany in 1970, Derrick was the proud middle son of six children born to Benjamin and Mamie Ruth Jeter.

Raised in Newport News, Virginia, Derrick graduated with the Class of 1989 from Warwick High School, where he was recognized for his achievements in track and field even earning a feature in the school's Gazette. A natural storyteller with a magnetic personality, Derrick's love for life and people could fill any room.

In 1989, he enlisted in the United States Army National Guard, proudly serving in both Maryland and Virginia during the Gulf War and later at Guantánamo Bay following 9/11. He retired in 2009 after 20 years of honorable service as a 13 Bravo Field Artilleryman.

A man of deep faith, Derrick began his Christian journey at New Beginnings Ministries in Hampton, VA. He lived his life as a servant to others, always showing up with love, humor, and unwavering support for his family and friends.

In 1999, Derrick met the love of his life, Darlene, and they were married on March 20, 2004. Together, they built a life full of laughter, travel, family, and joy, raising their family in Oxon Hill, Maryland a place he proudly called home.

Derrick was known for his laughter, storytelling, and heartfelt presence at every family event. Whether it was snapping photos, cheering on his beloved Washington Commanders (Redskins), or simply calling to check in, he made sure those around him felt loved.

He was preceded in death by his beloved mother, Mamie Ruth Jeter.
