Donald Charles Reid passed away peacefully in his sleep from natural causes at his home in Naples, Florida, on September 14, 2024. As he wished, Donald was subsequently cremated at a Naples, Florida crematorium on September 27, 2024. He was 74 years old.

Donald was born to the proud parents of Wendell Alvin Reid and Bernice Ernestine Mercer Reid in Baltimore, Maryland. He came into this world as a twin to Ronald C. Reid and as a younger brother to Wendell E. Reid (Skippy) and Phillip B. J. Reid.

Donald attended St. Cecilia and St. Ann Catholic schools and later graduated from Northwestern High School in 1970, where he played Junior Varsity football and wrestled.

In 1973, following the proud family tradition of his uncle Lloyd Johnson and his two older brothers, Donald joined the Baltimore City Police Department (BPD), where he, over the years, was assigned to various district street patrols and other duties at their BPD headquarters.

After 23 years of successful service, Donald retired from the BPD in 1996. Throughout his career and retirement, he was a member of two police unions, the Vanguard Justice Society and the Fraternal Order of Police.

Once retired, Donald immediately began working various private security related jobs in and around Baltimore, which he treasured. Longing to be near his twin brother and older brother Phillip, he decided to relocate to Naples, Florida in 2011. Once arriving in Naples, he continued to pursue his passion for private security assignments throughout the area until his passing.

Donald is survived by his daughter Ebony Reid, whom he loved, was proud of, and cherished. He is also survived by his two brothers, Phillip and Ronald, and numerous cousins, nieces, and nephews. He was predeceased by his parents and oldest brother Wendell.

Donald loved everyone, and truly valued his "American Dream" retirement life in Florida. He especially loved and visited numerous beaches around Florida, including those in Key West.

Donald will be sorely missed by his family, friends, and private security colleagues.
