



Dorothy Haizlip

June 24, 1924 - July 3, 2022

Dorothy Jackson Haizlip was born on June 24, 1924 to the late Thomas Jackson and Bertha Lewis Jackson at Harlem Hospital in New York City. Her family moved to Richmond, VA when she was a young child. Dorothy was educated in Richmond, Virginia and graduated from Virginia Randolph High in Glen Allen, Va. She also attended a secondary school where she earned her degree in business. After graduating, Dorothy went to work at a meat company in the Richmond area. Dorothy married at an early age which ended in divorce. Dorothy moved to Washington, DC in 1954 where she worked as a domestic worker. She was later employed by a private firm called ARA for over 30 years located in the Pentagon. She served all manner of people, both private and military personnel. Through hard work Dorothy became the manager of the pastry shop. Dorothy retired from the Pentagon in 1989.

Dorothy was baptized and gave her life to Christ at the age of 12 at First Baptist Church Washington Park. Later, after her move to Washington, DC, she became a member of Salem Baptist Church for over 30 years. She eventually became a member of Randall Memorial United Methodist Church in 2010 to serve where husband served until her death. Dorothy served as a member and head of the Methodist usher board until she relinquished her title to the younger generation.

Dorothy met (through a mutual friend) and later married John Mark Haizlip on

May 10, 1968. They were married until he preceded her in death in 2007. Dorothy was the 5th of 8 children who all preceded her in death (Edwin, Albert, Earl, Solomon, Purcell, Virginia and Boozy). Her step-sons (John Hardy and Norman Gary) also preceded her in death. She is survived by nine grandchildren - Denise Haizlip-Harrod (Bruce), Iris Haizlip-Ford (George), Michael Haizlip, Leslie Haizlip, Deitra Gilbert (Harvey), Gina Haizlip, Ashley Burris-Frazier (Keston), Jacobi Hawkins, and Angel Love. She is survived by 14 great-grandchildren and 10 great great grandchildren. She is also survived by a devoted niece (Carrie Jackson) and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, friends and church family.
