



Mr. Edgar H. Dinkins

August 12, 1923 - November 29, 2024

Mr. Edgar Dinkins, age 101, died peacefully of natural causes on November 29, 2024, at the Lisner Home in Washington, DC. Mr. Dinkins transitioned knowing that he was visited by family in the days before he left us. He especially enjoyed his phone calls and visits with nephew Paul Simon and his weekly visits and daily conversations with cousin Catherine Grant.

Affectionately known as “Dink” to many friends and simply Edgar by family, Mr. Dinkins graduated from Armstrong High School in Washington DC. Having served his country in World War II, Mr. Dinkins became a well-known and respected employee of the U.S. Postal Service for over 30 years. He performed his postal carrier duties with pride and professional attention. His nearly photographic memory of DC streets and neighborhoods was legendary. He followed the local professional sports teams as a fan, but with a very critical eye. Winning teams received measured praise and losing teams were given doses of sharp criticism. Mr. Dinkins could hold the attention of both the churchgoers and the nightclub crowds with his vivid and entertaining recollections and reflections of the famous and infamous characters that made DC’s history special and unique. Mr. Dinkins was a dear friend to many and loved by more than a few.

Mr. Dinkins is survived by nephew Paul Simon and cousins Barbara, Catherine, Joyce, Millie, Sheila and several nieces and nephews.

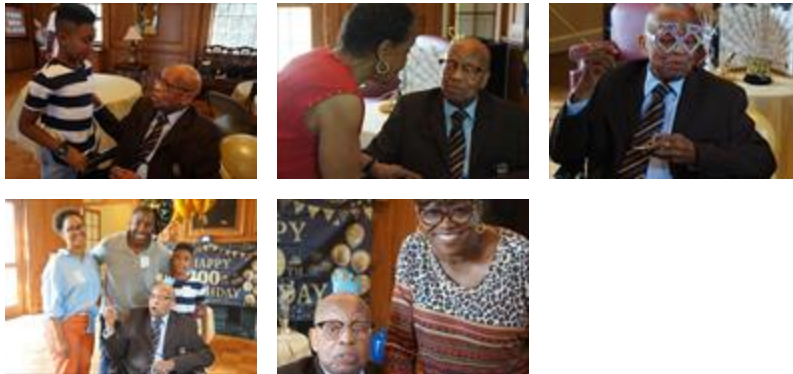

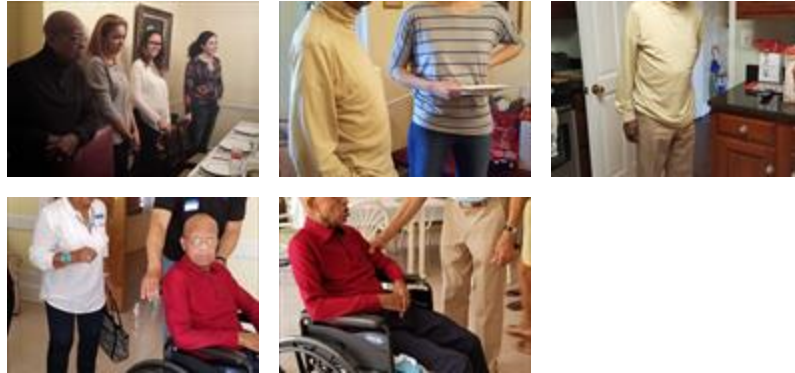
