## Obituary

In January 1970, Gene joined the United States Air Force. He proudly served his country until January 1976. During the course of his time in the Air Force, his love for billiards grew. He was an avid player and participated in many billiards tournaments. He was Honorably Discharged at the rank of Staff Sergeant.

Immediately after being discharged from the USAF, Gene began working at Georgetown University as a Sergeant for the Department of Public Safety. When he would learn of something new or shocking, his favorite response was always, "FOR REALLLLL!"

Gene loved scrabble, chess and was a keen billiards player. His favorite pastime was going to the pool hall. He participated in leagues, many tournaments and won numerous trophies. After retirement, he still played pool and his love for chess increased. He would play chess with friends all around town. One of his spots was at Tanger Outlets in Oxon Hill, MD, where he would meet up with friends, shoot the breeze and play chess. As a foodie, he knew where all the best spots were. He enjoyed going to new places to have a drink and eat only the best. If he wasn't trying out a new spot, you could always find him at Outback or Olive Garden. And, he was always down for a slice of lemon meringue pie or a pint of chocolate ice cream.

Gene also loved to shop. You would rarely see him in the same outfit twice. He made sure he always had the latest and stayed sharp. Gene also loved going to the movies. He checked the paper frequently to see the times to go watch the latest flick. He and his buddies would also frequent 7 Eleven to get coffee and play the numbers. He was avid about playing daily and hit often; always hoping to hit the big one.

He is preceded in death by his mother, Helen; father, George; brother, Roscoe; sister, Lydia; and daughter, Candace.
