



Felton Thomas

August 16, 1917 - November 29, 2016

Died peacefully at home in Silver Spring, MD on November 29, 2016. He was born in Macon, GA, one of eight children of Solomon and Janie Thomas. He began government service in the Navy in 1943, during WWII and was honorably discharged in 1946. After the war, he worked for Signal Intelligence Service (SIS), which became the National Security Agency in 1952. He served as a computer security specialist and supervisor of critical systems until retirement in 1983. He was a Freemason, a founding member of the Queens Chapel Civic Assoc., and in retirement became a certified Lapidary. Felton and his beloved wife Irene, who died in 2014, were married for 69 years. He is survived by his children, Vincent, Charles, and Barbara, and many nieces and nephews. An informal prayerful vigil will be held on Saturday, May 20, 2017 from 2:30 - 4 pm at MARSHALL-MARCH FUNERAL HOME, 4308 Suitland Rd., Suitland, MD. Gathering for the internment service for Felton Thomas will be at 10:15 am on May 22, 2017 at Arlington National Cemetery.
