



Floyd Roosevelt Davis

October 1, 1954 - June 25, 2022

Retired USMC Major Floyd Roosevelt Davis, 67, of Washington, DC, died Saturday June 25, 2022, at United Medical Center in Washington DC.

Born in Ninety-Six, South Carolina, on October 1, 1954 to his late parents, Ethel (Boston) Davis and Roosevelt Davis. After graduating from Edgewood High School in Ninety-Six, he went on to graduate with Honors from Lehman College with a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science and MBA from Columbia University both in NYC. Floyd joined the US Marine Corps Officer Program and rose to the rank of a Major. He was a highly decorated officer in the US Marine Corp and served his country with honor and distinction for more than 20 years, including a tour in the Vietnam War. After he retired from the US Marine Corps he was recruited by Lockheed Martin to continue work in a military contractor capacity until he retired. Floyd was a generous man with a brilliant mind who was always yearning to learn and expand his knowledge. He could hold an intellectual conversation on any subject matter, with authority. We will miss his sharp mind and wit.

He was preceded in death by his brother James Melvin Davis, sisters - Gertrude Davis, Bessie Mae Davis, and Lillian Bell Davis. In addition, he was preceded in death by his aunt, Bessie Farrow.

He is survived by his brother, Willie Roosevelt Davis of Greenwood, SC and sister Geneva Davis of Chicago, Ill. He is also survived by his two nieces,

whom he played a significant role in raising them: Malecia Davis-Shabazz of Greenbelt, MD, who was like a daughter to him and his caretaker in retirement, and Anita Davis of West Orange, NJ, who was his like-minded sparring niece. In addition, he is survived by his nieces - April Turner and Maria Davis and nephews - Michael Hair, Roosevelt Davis Jr., Jermaine Davis, Jamie Davis, Christopher Davis and host of great nieces, great nephews, cousins, and family friends.
