George H. Jackson was born July 6, 1938 in Gumberry, NC to the late Willie James Jackson and Wilhimenia (Berry) Jackson. He quietly transitioned from this earthly world at Washington Hospital Center's Intensive Care Unit, surrounded by his wife and loving family on December 27, 2020.

He was raised in the Midlothian and Richmond, VA area. Enlisting in the Army in his youth. During his service he earned the Good Conduct Medal and commendations in the areas of sharpshooter and marksman for tank artillery and firearms, respectively and was Honorably Discharged. He later moved and spent the latter years of his life in the Washington, DC area. Pursuing an occupation as a construction worker in his early career, he worked on many residential and commercial buildings in the DC metropolitan area, with his older brother, James. He later entered federal service at the National Institutes of Health (NIH), where he received awards and commendations for his work. He retired from NIH after 20 years of service.

George enjoyed music, relaxing and spending time with family. You witnessed a twinkle in his eyes and some of his biggest smiles when he spent time with his grandchildren. He was definitely a sports enthusiast, spending lots of time in his recliner talking and arguing at the commentators and players on the television while watching football, basketball, golf, and tennis. He was a soft spoken, quiet, gentle person of few words, responding mostly with a chuckle,

two or more words, a short comment or a question. His laughter, warm and loving nature will truly be missed.

He was preceded in death by his parents, brothers, James J. Jackson, Jr., Willie L. Jackson, Alvin Jackson, and two sisters Bernice V. Thomas and Mary E. Williams. He is survived by his wife of 45 years Williree Jackson, two daughters, LaVonne Darlene Blake (Marcel) and Gina Burnette (Damon, Sr.); brother-in-law, George Williams, sister-in-law, Marie Jackson; seven grandchildren, four great grandchildren and a host of nieces and nephews, loving family members and friends.
