Harold Thomas was born May 20, 1909 to the late Irene and William A. Thomas in Washington, DC, the youngest of seven sons.

Harold was educated in the District of Columbia public schools. After graduating from Armstrong High School he went on to serve in the United States Army Air Corp where he was he was trained as a meteorologist. When he was honorably discharged from the military he relocated to Montclair, New Jersey. He returned home to continue his long and prestigious career with the Weather Bureau in Washington D.C. He retired from the North American Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration NOAA in 1950.

Harold was an avid reader, he loved sharing his experiences and providing advice on a wide range of topics. He also enjoyed traveling and playing bridge with his close friends.

His was a member of the Plymouth Congregational Church and supported his church faithfully until his illness kept him from attending services regularly.

His devoted sister-in-law, Edith V. Thomas, leads the family in mourning their

loss. Harold is also survived by two nieces, Sandra Gaskins Freddie and Lillian Colston; a nephew, Rev. Edward Thomas Jr.; and other relatives and friends.
