Hazel Viola Boden Lucas born Tuesday, July 3, 1951 to her parents, John Eclipse Boden/Bodin (1925 – 2016) and Agnes Elizabeth Harley/Boden (1926 – 1983). A very funny story about her birth. Her family was living in an apartment over a laundry mat on Georgia Avenue NW, Washington DC. Her mother was attending to her sister Sheila (who was 3 years old at the time) in the bathroom. Her mother had a pain, and Hazel was born in that bathroom of course, it's been a family joke for years.

Hazel grew up in SE DC until age 16 and then her family moved to Sheriff Road NE DC. She attended public schools in Washington DC (Turner Elementary, Garfield Elementary, Frederick Douglas Jr. High, Ballou High and graduated from Spingarn High School in 1970). Hazel earned her Associate degree from PG Community College in 1987.

Hazel entered the workforce at age 14 (DC Department of Recreation) as a recreation aide. She retired from the Federal Government (US General Accounting Office) in 2003. At GAO, Hazel's career went from a Clerk Typist GS-2 and ended as Manager of Property Management GS-14.

Hazel met her future husband, Aaron, in March 1967. Aaron asked Hazel for a chance in May 1967 and of course she said yes. In November 1969, Aaron asked Hazel to marry him and again, she said yes. On Saturday, August

22,1970, Aaron and Hazel were married. From this union, they were blessed with 2 gifts....Leon Maurice Lucas (1970) and Jay (Jamar) Aaron Lucas (1979).

Hazel leaves behind a devoted loving husband of 53 years. Two loving sons Leon (Erika) and Jay (Amy), two precious granddaughters Logan and Layla. 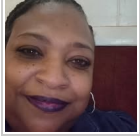
