April 5, 1916 - July 29, 2006

Isaiah Henry Gadson entered this world on April 5, 1916. He was one of eleven children born to Elijah and Essye Gadson. He departed this life to be with the Lord on July 29, 2006 at Providence Hospital.

Isaiah was a Washingtonian, raised in the Deanwood section of Northeast Washington, DC and attended Armstrong High School. He joined the U. S. Navy after leaving high school where he received an honorable discharge. In the early 1950's, Isaiah gave his life to the Lord and joined Metropolitan Wesley A.M.E. Zion Church where he served on the senior usher board for many years. In 1954, Isaiah married Marion Brown. Isaiah loved his family and enjoyed cooking for them. His special dish was baked macaroni and cheese with tomato sauce. He retired for the General Services Administration branch of the Federal Government after thirty-three years of service. Isaiah was a sports fanatic. He would watch any sports related event, but baseball was his favorite. His favorite team was the Washington Senators and he was happy to hear that Washington, DC brought baseball back to the city. Isaiah, a quiet man, will be remembered for his witty sayings and sharp tongue.

He leaves to cherish his memory his wife, Marion Gadson; daughters, Denise Gadson and Raynell Cecil Wall; three stepsons, Roland Swingon, Reginald Margestine and Ralph Charlotte, deceased Brown; two sisters, Sara Rollins and Ester Atkins; fourteen grandchildren, twenty-two great-grandchildren and

a host of other relatives and friends. Isaiah's parents, seven brothers and one sister preceded him in death.
