



## Rev. James T. Jackson

December 17, 1945 - October 1, 2021

Rev. James T. Jackson was born on Monday December 17, 1945 in Rison, Maryland and was called home to be with the Lord on Friday October 1, 2021 in Richmond Virginia at VA Hospital. James was the eighth of eleven children to the late Isaac and Mary Jackson. At the age of 13, he was baptized and joined the Mt. Hope Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. R.L. Young. As a native to Charles County Maryland, he received his secondary education in the Charles County public school system, graduating from Pomonkey High School in Indian Head, Maryland June of 1964. James enlisted in the U.S Army and served his country for 2 years. He married Judy in 1969 and from that union he becoming a devoted and loving father to three children although that marriage ended in divorce, they remained friends.

James retired from the Bureau of Engraving in Washington, DC September 30, 1996. He had a desire and passion for the Word of God. Rev. James T Jackson pastored Union Baptist Church for 21 years in Gordonsville, VA with an undying love and dedication in serving his members. After he retired as pastor of Union Baptist Church he relocated to Richmond Virginia, where he became a member of Mission of Hope Ministries in Chesterfield, Virginia in 2013. There he would serve as Assistant Pastor under the leadership of Pastor James Purnell Sr. until his heavenly departure.

James leaves a devoted family to cherish intangible memories: one son,

Darick Brown, two daughters Isha Jackson, and Chatarica Jackson; three brothers and three sisters-in-law: Leroy and Missy Jackson, Clarence and Shannon Jackson, and Edward Mary Jackson; two sisters and one brother-in-law Blanche Rogers, and Christine and Edward Johnson; eleven grandchildren; a host of nieces and nephews along with countless number of church family and friends.
