He transitioned from this life peacefully at his home in Washington, D.C. on Thursday, June 9, 2022, at the age of 66.

Jerome, along with his best friend, Reginald (Reggie) Collier lived at Astor Place for over fifteen years, the place he was most proud of and affectionately called his "home".

Jerome received his education from D.C. public schools. He enlisted in the U.S. Navy in 1976 where he earned his GED and received an honorable discharge in 1982.
