Philip passed away in 2003. With her health still declining, she developed Alzheimer's and after a massive heart attack she moved in with her daughter, Joyce. Joyce and her son Sean provided loving care and patience and vowed she would never go into a nursing home. Sean and Marcelina went to school and took the home health aide course. This was a great help to Joyce(who is sick) and her mother. June Delores Miller Bradshaw(Bush) went home to be with the lord on the morning of December 5, 2020 in Washington, DC after a gradual decline in her health,

she moved in with her daughter; Joyce until her death. She was surrounded and supported by loving family members during the last days of her life. June was preceded in death by her father, Roscoe C. Miller and mother, Margaret E. Powell, both of Raleigh, North Carolina; sixteen siblings, husband, Philip Bush, daughter-in-law, Luada and grandson, Raymond, III.
