



## Junius Linwood Jeffreys Jr.

Early in life, Junie was an avid dirt bike rider and competed in the American Motorcyclist Association, where his passion and love for the sport shone as he won many awards and prizes.

Junie attended Prince George’s County public schools until matriculating to Archbishop McNamar High School, graduating in 1988. After graduation, Junie followed in his father’s footsteps, where he began working at Dominion Electric. As a team member, his talent was recognized, and recommendations were made on his behalf to attend electrical school. On June 7, 2003, Junius completed his electrical apprenticeship and training through Local Union 26, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers. Truland Electric Systems was the first company that employed Junie after graduation, and it turned out to be a long and successful tenure. Projects he was allowed to work on included the Pentagon, Woodrow Wilson Bridge, John Edgar Hoover Building, and Branch Avenue Metro Station. These were special to Junie, and he would often reflect

on and highly speak about them.

Junie was indeed a family man. Spending quality time with his family, often entertaining himself with the remote more than others. The highlight of his TV programming was WWE wrestling and old western shows. He really could have been named "Walker Texas Ranger". His sons, Anthony, Arren, and Akiel enjoyed him in some great moments, including skating, football, basketball, bowling, and an all-you-can-eat buffet to the end of the day. When they say that he is an on-time God, Junie witnessed that testimony as his first granddaughter, Niomi, was a light in his life from the moment he saw her. The angels were watching, and God was listening as Junie sat, smiled, and laughed with Niomi. Peace, love, and tranquility were what this newfound moment represented to him.

Junius Jeffrey, Jr. left behind a long-lasting legacy. He was known for his intellect, joyful spirit, and above-and-beyond ability to help others. He will be remembered, and with those memories, strength will be
