Obituary

Mother Burgess, as she was affectionally called was a quiet, humble, and obedient servant of God. She possessed a peaceable, easy-going spirit that drew people to her. She spoke only good things to everyone she encountered, and even in her final days, kind words flowed from her lips. Faith was the foundation of her home. She made church attendance and active participation a priority, raising her family to know and love the Lord.

Music was one of Mother Burgess's greatest joys. She played the keyboard alongside her beloved husband, who played guitar, and together they glorified God with their hearts and hands. Her love for Jesus was evident in every conversation, and she was always ready to share His love with anyone who would listen.

Throughout her life, Laura served others with grace and compassion, in the church, the community, the medical field, and through childcare. Her life was a living testimony of Matthew 25:40: "Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me."
