Laura Cornelius Ashworth Young was born July 15, 1949, to the late parents of Lawrence Ashworth and Joseree Caldwell Ashworth. She was the third child of seven children. She grew up in High Point, NC, graduating from Ragsdale High School. Following graduation, she moved to Washington, DC. She was employed by several service agencies before finding her career move at the U.S. Department of State, where she served 38 years before retiring.
