



## Lillian G. Booze

Lillian Gertrude Booze, 93, of Hyattsville, MD passed away peacefully at home on November 16, 2021. She received her angel wings having lived a long life, full of love and joy and will be missed dearly.

Lillian was born September 3, 1928 at home and delivered by a midwife in Pittsylvania County, VA to the late James E. Day and Rentha Thomas Day. She was the seventh of nine children and the last surviving sibling of William, Raymond, James, Roosevelt; Clara, Armentha, Sally and Loretta.

She received her education in the public schools of Pittsylvania County located in the Commonwealth of Virginia. During the early years of her life, Lillian worked at several Drycleaners as a Laundry Aide where she became interested in alterations. Shortly afterward, she resided in South-East Washington, D.C. Lillian was united in Holy Matrimony to the predeceased Clarence David Booze for 39 years. She gave her life to Christ at a very early age and joined The Greater First Baptist Church of Mount Pleasant Plains until her health prevented her. She cherished praising the Lord and served on the Usher and Flower Ministries.

In 1968 she embarked on a new career in the U.S. & Publisher Liaison Division/Children's Literature Section at the Library of Congress until her

retirement in June 1997.
