She was a friend to everyone, many would come to her with their problems and she was always there to listen and to do whatever she could to help.

At an early age she accepted Christ as her personal Savior, she became a member of the Woodridge Bibleway Church in Washington, DC under the tutelage of Bishop George McCray; there her mother also became a member and her children were raised there.

Mother Covert was still active and full of life at 94; going to the store, making her appointments, and various other activities. She was still cooking and what a great cook she was; people loved her cheese and fruit cakes which she continued to make up to the end.

She entered into holy matrimony to Frank Covert, Sr. and from this union was born 4 children; Frank, Jr. (Tyrone), Roger (who preceded her in death), Barbara and Alphonzo.
