November 4, 1922 - January 2, 2021

Lloyd Oscar Moore peacefully passed from this life into eternal life on January 2, 2021. He was born on November 4, 1922 in Cullen, VA to the late Levi and Sarah Moore. He graduated from Charlotte Training High School in 1939 and joined the US Army. A World War II veteran and recipient of the Good Conduct Medal, the European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal and the Order of Liberation Commendation from General Charles de Gaulle, he served with honor until 1945.

After military service, he attended Virginia State College and received a Bachelor of Science in Industrial Education. While in college, he joined the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity (Nu Psi Chapter), and met the love of his life Elizabeth "Beth" Lewis. After graduating in 1948, he moved to Washington, DC and taught at Lofton's School of Tailoring until he opened Lloyd's Custom Tailors, which he owned and operated until he retired.

Lloyd married his college sweetheart in November 1950 and they were blessed with one child. Lloyd and Beth affectionately referred to each other as "Moe." Their lives were filled with laughter and they frequently gathered with neighbors and family for various occasions and celebrations.

Lloyd has joined his beloved Beth in eternity. Also preceding him in death were his siblings Roscoe, Rockfellow and Marion. His memory will be

cherished by his loving daughter, Janet Evans Watkins; grandchildren, Mia and Raymond Evans; brother, David Moore (Ella); nieces, Olivia Moore and Evelyn Scott; nephew, David Moore, Jr. and many cousins and dear friends.
