Obituary - Lucius Morris

Lucius Morris passed away peacefully on August 21, 2022. He was born on March 1, 1935 in Social Circle, GA, to the late Robert and Myrtle Morris. The family resided in Social Circle, GA until around 1940 during the great migration when the family moved to the Washington DC area where Lucius was raised and educated.

Educated in the Washington, DC public school system, Lucius graduated from Dunbar High School in 1953 and was at that time commissioned as a 2 nd Lt into the US Army, Signal Corp. He served 2 years of dedicated military service, receiving many high achieving awards and an honorable discharge. Lucius was employed as an electronic engineer for the National Security Agency, Ft Meade, MD for 35 years, retiring with dedicated and honorable service in 1993.

Lucius was a man of many talents; he was an avid fisherman, often times taking his mother, Myrtle, who loved fishing also, with him on his fishing expeditions. He also loved hunting small game with his uncles who taught him so much! He was a true gardener, planting and watering trees and shrubs faithfully and keeping his yard always beautiful. And Lucius loved automobiles which he kept immaculate and fine-tuned at all times! He was an avid audiophile, starting his own home-based business "Dynamic Sound" which serviced most of the eastcoast audiophiles. This business progressed exceptionally well until 2 years ago when his health began to wane and he

closed it down.

Above everything was Lucius' love of God. He was baptized at the tender age of 10 at the Vermont Ave Baptist Church, Washington DC, serving at numerous local churches in the DC area and holding various positions within those congregations. In 2001 he graduated from the Washington Bible College, Lanham, MD, majoring in Adult Education, always preparing himself for God's work, and preparing himself to help others. His most recent church home was Gethsemane Baptist Church, DC where he worshipped until his passing.

Lucius was a devoted family man, having married his high school sweetheart, Dolores Washington, in Oct 1958, 63 years!

Lucius and Dolores were blessed with two precious children, Karen Regina (1959) and Keith Wayne (1965) now deceased. This was a very close family, traveling together to many places and always vacationing together. Karen sent them on a wonderful cruise to Europe to celebrate their 50th wedding anniversary.

Lucius will be sorely missed by those whom he left behind. We are richer for having been loved by him. Let us keep his spirit alive as we remember him and love one another.

Lucius leaves to mourn his wife Dolores, daughter Karen, cousins, nieces, nephews, godchildren and dear friends.
