Margree McRae, daughter of the late James E. McRae and Lucille Livingston McRae, was born on March 7, 1932 in Red Springs, N.C. She was preceded in death by her brother, James H. McRae and her sister, Lula M. Campbell.

Margree graduated from Red Springs High School and later moved to Washington, DC where she met and married the late Ernest C. Walker. From that union two children were born, Deborah and Jacqueline.

Margree completed multiple business courses at Johnson Business School and was later employed by Union Trust Bank (Wells Fargo) where she took advantage of the many career opportunities.
