MARY ELLA HACKEY was born October 3, 1943, in Bishopville, South Carolina to the late David and Laura LaBoo (Davis). She departed this life May 23, 2026, while in hospice care at Meadow Park Nursing Home, where she resided since suffering from a stroke in 2019.

Mary started her education in South Carolina and later attended Baltimore City Public Schools after relocating to Baltimore, Maryland with her parents in 1952. Although she didn't graduate with a high school diploma, one of her proudest moments were when she received her GED from the Maryland Department of Education.

After retiring from Baltimore City Public Schools as a cafeteria worker for many years, she worked part-time as a receptionist at the senior living center where she resided – Abundant Life Towers II. She gave her life to Christ earlier in life and loved God even through her last days. She enjoyed listening to that good ole gospel music from artists like Rev. James Cleveland, Mahalia Jackson, and Pastor Shirley Caesar, but “Somebody Prayed for Me”, by Dorothy Norwood was her favorite song.

She was affectionately known as Mama, Granna, Kid, Kitty, Cat and Monkey to many. She enjoyed striking up a conversation with others and her demeanor was always pleasant, even with the caregivers from the nursing

home throughout different stages of her illness. Some of her favorite pastimes we're going to church, enjoying an early morning (5:00 a.m.) cup of coffee and word puzzles. She also enjoyed preparing meals for her family, especially fried fish & minced barbecue.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Raymond E. Hackey. Mary leaves to cherish her memory: three daughters, Shelrae Johnson (Hackey), Anita Turner, and Yolanda Hicks; three grandchildren, Deleccio, Tyshae and Paul; three great grandchildren, Camya, Chelsea and Dassane, and a host of other relatives and friends.
