“ *Our Beloved Michael*

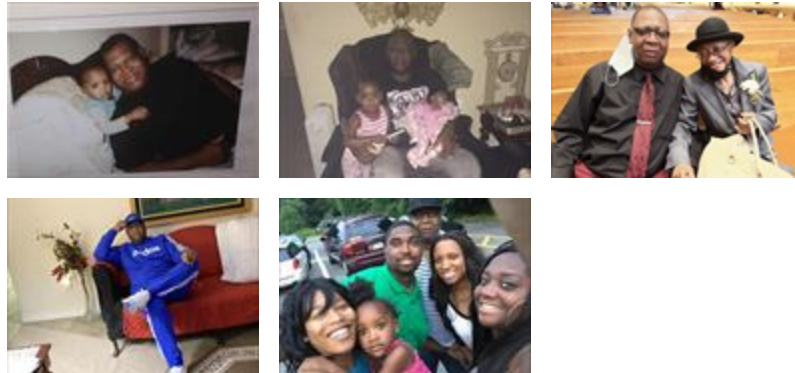

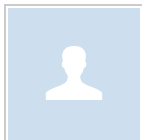
