Mildred Viola Cofield

On Thursday February 11, 2021, Mildred Viola Cofield of Washington DC died peacefully at the Arbor Ridge Assisted Living facility of the Riderwood Village retirement community two days shy of her 92nd birthday.

She was born in Philadelphia, PA, on the 13th of February 1929. Her early childhood years were spent largely in the care of her maternal grandparents Rolly and Mattie Desper in Louisa, VA. She attended elementary school in Louisa and when she reached early teen years she moved with her mother, Beatrice Dixon, to Washington DC and was graduated from Dunbar SHS. Shortly after, she met and married Joseph W. Lane. That union produced two children, Joseph and Karen.

She worked arduously her whole life excelling at bookkeeping and accounting for the original Industrial Bank of Washington branch on U Street, then at the Dept. of Interior and for almost three decades for the United States Air Force at Bolling AFB and Andrews AFB HQ Systems Command. After retiring from the federal arena, she met and married Dr. Hardy Cofield of Enfield, North Carolina with whom she lived the next three decades. Dr. Cofield predeceased her in 2015.

She is survived by her son Joseph W. Lane Jr. and daughter Karen L. Lewis and her husband James Lewis III. along with her grand-children, Jennifer N. Lewis and Christopher J. Lewis, as well as many nieces and nephews on both

sides of her family. Viewing is open to all; however due to COVID-19 restrictions, the service is restricted to immediate family only. We ask for your understanding in this time of emergency and grief.
