Mildred Victoria Kelly the daughter of the late Nettie and James Robinson was born on April 20, 1933, in Hopewell Virginia. She was affectionately called “Little Sister” because she was the second of five children.

Mildred grew up in a very loving home. She completed Arlington Height Elementary School and Carter G. Woodson Piedmont Nursing School and Saint Phillips School of Nursing where she received her Registered Nurse degree.

In 1967 Mildred was united in Holy Matrimony to her late husband Robert L. Kelly. After the wedding they resided in Richmond, Virginia for one year. They later migrated to Washington, DC. They were married for 22 years before his death.

Mildred enjoyed her career and retired from the Veterans Administration Hospital after 34 years of service.

### A Time of Harvest

Mildred and Robert joined Salem Baptist Church in 1968 where they worshiped and served untiringly until his death. Mildred was a Deaconess, a

member of the Tuesday evening Bible Study, the Pauline B. Haywood Home Ministry, Sunday School, the Senior Usher Board, the Afrocentric Committee, and the Silver Strands Senior Ministry. On Sunday, October 13, 2019, Mildred joined First Baptist Church of Highland Park. She loved music, singing, reading, embroidery, and traveling. Mildred and her sister Beulah visited Germany, France, Italy, Belgium, Austria, and Switzerland. They also traveled to South America, Alaska, Hawaii, and several of the Caribbean Islands. During the latter part of her years, their sister Edith and their brother Willie joined them in their local travels.
