Missionary Justine Littlejohn Sanders was born in Union, SC on July 24th, 1911.

She was the first of seven 7 children of Bessie and Fred Littlejohn. She had only one child, Benjamin F. Littlejohn Sr. who preceded her in death in December of 1995.

In search of her life's calling, she left South Carolina and moved to Washington, DC. Once there, with little education and a lot of self determination, she became a valued part of the Nutrition Department Team at the National Institutes of Health NIH in Bethesda, Md. Justine retired from the government after 20 years of dedicated service.

While in Washington, DC; the Lord led Justine to her life's work and the Temple Church of God and Christ now known as Kelsey Temple COGIC. She offered both her life and service to the Lord as HIS faithful servant. ?
