



## Nellie Lewis Grant

March 4, 1930 - August 2, 2008

Nellie Lewis Grant of Silver Spring, Maryland departed this life on August 2, 2008.

She was the youngest of ten girls, two passed when infants, born to Martha Pitt Laws and John Colonius Laws. Seven of the eight remaining daughters earned college degrees from historically Black colleges. Mrs. Grant received her B.A. Degree from Howard University in 1952 and earned a Master's of Education Degree in Guidance Counseling from the American University, Washington, DC in 1979. She was an educator in the Washington area for more than 32 years. An active member of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority since her college years, Mrs. Grant considered her sisterhood essential to her completeness. Never one to look at a blank sheet of paper and not fill it, she wrote, produced and directed the play Doodling, which premiered at Howard University's Cramton Auditorium in 1979. Doodling also had several runs at the Lisner Auditorium, George Washington University between 1980 and 1982. Nellie Grant's last work was an inspirational publication titled Waiting in the Wings. Those who will miss Nellie Grant include nieces and nephews spanning three generations and countless friends and associates.
