



## Orland C. Jones

November 5, 1929 - October 26, 2017

Orland C Jones, 87, passed away Thursday, October 26, 2017 at Doctors Community Hospital in Lanham, MD.

Orland was born November 5, 1929 in East Rainelle, WV. On July 26, 1954 he was united in marriage to Nedra E McMillion in Clifton Forge, VA. Orland served in the United States Air Force and was a graduate of Morris Harvey College in Charleston, WV. He led a long and distinguished career with the United States Treasury Department in Washington, DC and with the Comptroller of Maryland in Annapolis, MD.

Orland and Nedra made their home in Forestville, MD since 1968 and were active members of the First Baptist Church of Suitland for more than 50 years.
