Otis Norris was born on March 29, 1942, in Saluda, South Carolina to the late Joe Ben and Annie C. Norris. He peacefully departed this life on September 13, 2025 at the Sterling Care Nursing Home, Bethesda, MD.

Otis graduated from the Saluda County Public Schools. After high school, he served in the United States Army, where he received an honorary discharge.
