Mom received numerous Honorariums and Certificates. She was an avid

fighter for human rights and racial equality. Mom was a member of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People. She participated in the March on Washington on August 28, 1963 and also marched and demonstrated in the early 60's against racial injustice in the South.
