Patricia B. Miller, 77, entered her Heavenly home on April 19th, 2018 while in care at the Mandrin Hospice House in Harwood, MD. Patricia, affectionately known as “Pat” and “Aunt Pat,” was born on October 7, 1940 in Jacksonville, FL to her mother, Ruth Brown, and father, Elmo Davis, both of whom preceded her in death.

Pat was a graduate of New Stanton High School in Jacksonville. She went on to attend and earn a degree from Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University in Tallahassee. Pat served as a civilian information and technology professional for the federal government for most of her career, with stops in Washington, D.C., California and finally, Fort McPherson in Atlanta before she retired in the late 1990s. With a zest for keeping busy, Pat continued to use her many gifts and talents during her retirement. She worked part time at the Hallmark Cards store on Fort Gillem, was later licensed as a real estate appraiser and ran a successful appraisal business for many years. She then went on to work for nearly 10 years as a guide at Turner Field during Atlanta Braves home games before finally retiring a second time after working as an ambassador at the College Football Hall of Fame in Atlanta.

Pat was a talented seamstress. Her mother and grandmother taught and developed her love of sewing. She would often make or alter her own clothes, and loved to make gifts for those dear to her. She was also a talented cook. Pat liked to discover and test new recipes, and share her passion with others. She also enjoyed listening to music and had an extensive album collection.

Pat was always very positive, both in her words of others and in her trust that God's grace was always more than sufficient.

She was a devoted member to Riverdale First United Methodist Church in Riverdale, Ga. She regularly attended Bible study, and cared for the sick and shut in.

Pat moved to Maryland in 2017 to be closer to family. She is survived by a host of nieces, nephews, grandnieces and grandnephews, and dear friends.
