Pauline G. Daniels was born to the late John L. and Julia B. Coghill on August 30, 1912 in King George County, Virginia. After enduring a lengthy illness, Pauline was called from labor to reward on September 6, 2006 at Future Care Pineview Nursing Home, located in Clinton, Maryland.

Pauline attended Welcome Elementary School in Welcome, Virginia. She graduated from Union High School in Bowling Green, Virginia. She moved to the Washington, D. C. area in the early 1930's and was employed by the Library of Congress, where she retired after thirty years of service.

Her passion for education, politics and civil rights was evidenced by her membership and participation in the presidential election of Bill Clinton. Also, she received many honors and awards from the NAACP coalition.

Pauline was preceded in death by her beloved husband of thirty-five years, Raymond Daniels. She also leaves to mourn one sister, Edna M.
